 - a. Transportation Discussion with Ben Weiss
 - i. There has been a lot of change in your neighborhood, potentially more coming, new park section west of England and a new street called Doherty Drive.
 - ii. The federal grant they received only funded 60% of the transportation need. Decided not to build out sidewalks and bike lanes in the first stage, de-prioritized bus lines from Mountain Line.

 - iv. Potential new bike routes connecting the Milwaukee Trail and the Mullan Road corridor. There is funding for a bike path along Mullan Road between Reserve and Mary Jane Boulevard.
