

## Miller Creek Neighborhood Council Leadership Team Meeting Minutes

June 18, 2024; 6pm  
Fire Station #5

Attendance: Alex Fregerio, Melissa Glueckert, Jen Pfeiffer, Lee Boman, Julie Anton, Diane Bickers, Medora O'Connor, and guest Aaron Wilson, Planning Manager, from City Transportation committee.

Meeting called to order by Alex Fregerio. Minutes of April and May meetings were approved.

1- Aaron Wilson led a discussion concerning our ideas and input for Lower Miller Creek Road intersection with Hwy 93. He took notes on our ideas, discussed budgets for monitoring traffic systems & controls. He cautioned that changes don't happen fast due to the approval process. He mentioned that Mountain Line is updating their plans, & ideas. They're discussing what 'On Demand Service' would look like. Aaron suggested we have a Mountain Line person speak at our General Meeting.

Aaron said the Msla Traffic Planning Committee is looking at maps, budgets, priorities of which Hwy 93 is on that list, for data collection on what traffic looks like & how it's changing. He suggested he return to our meeting in 2-3 months with maps, study results, and have updated information to share. Perhaps is another option for Speaker at our General Meeting.

2- Melissa Glueckert introduced the Neighborhood Action Plan Guide, a toolkit for Neighborhoods to set their priorities and plan of actions to achieve the M.C. Neighborhood's choice of goals. Step #1 is to go through the City's Strategic Plan. Lee Boman volunteered to head the committee on this project. Medora O'Connor is willing to help with understanding the City Plan, then present those ideas for our Miller Creek Neighborhood choices.

3- Budget: to use our remaining balance of the monies allotted Miller Creek Neighborhood, it was decided to purchase 15 gift cards at \$50 each to be raffled off at our General Meeting in September. Alex will let Melissa know the number of gift cards to each business (The Den, Yokes, Linda Vista golf/restaurant. )
