If after your discussion you want to collectively share some of the traffic concerns you feel are important with Amber and I we'd appreciate it. I've been working with a few council members to try and make it easier to implement traffic management around schools and I'm happy to bring your input forward.

One other thing that I've mentioned at previous general meetings but didn't detail this year is more thoughts on the Pattee Creek/Pattee Canyon/Higgins intersection. We have consistently heard that public works does not want to put a traffic control of some sort at that spot because they are concerned it will encourage more through traffic onto Pattee Creek rather than utilizing Higgins and SW Higgins. That is why years ago they redid the intersection to offset it a bit. I will say I hear many different perspectives from the neighborhood on what should or should not happen at that street.
