Project Description:

Praxis – Building Knowledge for Action, a local community-based research firm , seeks energetic volunteers to conduct surveys with people experiencing homelessness on behalf of the City and County of Missoula, local businesses, and several nonprofit organizations. Survey results will be used as a foundation for planning efforts to address the needs of sheltered and unsheltered people living in Missoula. Volunteers will work in teams and be assigned to survey sites. Surveys will take approximately 15 to 30 minutes to complete.

Qualifications:

- Must be 18 or over
- Be a good communicator
- Previous interview experience is helpful, but not necessary (training will be provided)
- Have a cell phone for periodic check-ins during survey administration
- Be able to attend a training session
- Be available to administer surveys for a 4-hour shift
