Missoula City Council Seeks Applicants for Council Ward 2

The City of Missoula City Council is taking applications to fill a vacancy in Ward 2 following the resignation of Councilman Roy Houseman December 20. The person selected will fill the vacancy and serve until the results of the November 2, 2011 General Election are final. ~~first Monday in January 2012~~. Ward 2 lies entirely north of the Clark Fork River and includes ~~the Northside~~, the Westside, Grant Creek, and neighborhoods generally west of Reserve Street that are in the city limits. The City Council makes the final decision about the appointment. A majority vote of the members in office is required to appoint the new council member.

In order to be eligible for the office, applicants must

- Be a U.S. citizen
- Be at least 18 years of age
- Reside in Ward 2 for at least 60 days prior to being selected by City Council for the seat

- Be registered and qualified to vote.
