Monday Snow News

On Monday morning, City crews had completed snow-plowing work in 99 percent of the city. Street Superintendent Brian Hensel had crews working 14-hour shifts on the weekend and also made the decision to plow some residential streets with one pass in and out, so the streets were passable but not plowed curb-to-curb. Crews will return as time permits.

Crews started removing center berms at the edges of downtown this morning. When snowfall returned, they went to deicing on Reserve Street and in the Rattlesnake and Grant Creek on main streets and trouble spots.

Plans for the rest of the day include continuing thorough plowing of residential streets and working on center berm removal.
