Summer Tennis Camps

Enjoy learning tennis fundamentals in a fun, **low**-key setting. Regardless of skill level you will have the opportunity to improve your stroke and game strategy while having a great time! Two-week session begins August 13 with morning lessons for youth, evening classes for adults. Registration fee is \$35 (\$29 with resident discount) for youth, and \$75 (\$60 with resident discount) for adults.
