Short Detour Set for Russell Street Thursday, Nov. 15

A short detour will be in place on Russell Street around the railroad crossing at Ronan Street for work on the crossing on Thursday and possibly into Friday. Drivers can expect slight delays or plan to avoid the area.

Montana Rail Link workers will be repairing the crossing to smooth it out for traffic. City of Missoula Street Maintenance Division crews will lay new asphalt up to the railroad crossing.

The detour will begin at 8 a.m. Thursday. Northbound traffic will be detoured at Longstaff Street to Knowles Street and then back to Russell Street. Southbound traffic will be detoured at 11th Street to Garfield Street and Garfield Street to 14th Street, where the detour will take traffic back to Russell Street on 14th Street.
