CITY SEEKS APPLICATIONS FOR WARD 4 CITY COUNCIL SEAT

Council to choose successor in February

The City of Missoula is taking applications to fill the Ward 4 position on the City Council being vacated by Caitlin Copple. Ward 4 includes the southeastern part of Missoula. Please see the City [Ward Map](#) for specific boundaries.

The position will become effective upon the official resignation of Caitlin Copple, the incumbent, and the swearing in of her successor. The term of office continues until a successor is elected and qualified in the upcoming City election in November. The City Council will make the decision about the appointment; a majority of the City Council members is required. At the Feb. 9 City Council meeting, each City Council member may select one applicant to interview, and the interview order will be determined by drawing candidate names from a hat. Interviews will be conducted by the City Council's Committee of the Whole during business hours on Feb. 11 and continue on Feb. 18 if necessary. Once interviews are completed, the Council will vote on the appointment at the next City Council meeting.

Applicants must be a

- U.S. citizen,
- citizen of the State of Montana,
- resident of Ward 4 for 60 days prior to appointment,
- qualified elector registered and eligible to vote under state law, and
- at least 18 years of age.

The position pays \$1,168.59 per month plus City benefits. To apply for the position, candidates may complete an application form online on the City's website www.ci.missoula.mt.us/ward4 or pick up an application from the City Clerk Office, City Hall, 435 Ryman St., Missoula, MT 59802.
