2. Completion report on Bellevue Park irrigation system – Chris Boza

Well will be changed out by the end of the fiscal year. Contract is getting worked out within the city. New well parts will be needed to change the well out. The pump and controller need to be upgraded to accommodate a 35 gpm capacity. At this point the park will have a main line the entire length with gate valves and T's for future branches. Don't worry about the new trees that are bent they will grow fine.
