 2. Public comment on non-agenda items
 3. Status report on final engineering for construction of the city's two miles of the Grant Creek Bicycle-Pedestrian Trail
 4. Discussion of the federal Transportation Alternatives Program grant application
Missoula County plans to submit September 6 to extend the trail from the city-county line to Mellot Lane. The Grant Creek Trails Association will raise the 13.42 percent cash match. The association hopes to extend the trail to Snowbowl Road in the future, but felt the grant application would be more competitive if the section north of Mellot Lane (which includes an expensive retaining wall) was not included
 5. Discussion of the city engineer's request that the Parks and Recreation Department consider whether the planned Grant Creek Trail bridge across Grant Creek can provide emergency access/egress for residents in the Prospect and Prospect Meadows neighborhoods.
 6. Discussion of ongoing studies to see whether the existing southbound lane on Grant Creek Road at the I-90 interchange can be striped as two lanes. The grant to increase the number of southbound lanes on Grant Creek Road at the I-90 interchange was unsuccessful.
