Summary Description and rationale of project and funding sources:

Hellgate Park is a 3.85 acre public park located along East Broadway Street, along the banks of the Clark Fork River. The master plan was adopted in 2014, and in 2018 implementation began with the installation of a small dog park. The master plan includes improvements to the parking area, signage, trees, ADA access, walk in river access, restoration of native vegetation, and a small natural playground. The plan will be implented in phases, the most pressing immediate needs are better ADA access, parking improvements and signage. To date Impact Fees have been used to begin implementation of the master plan.

## History & Current Status: Impact if Cancelled or Delayed

Improved ADA access, parking and signage is critical as this park becomes more well known and popular amongst neighborhood residents and others. Because of it's location along the river, and the opportunity to provide walk in river access the popularity will likely increase greatly, especially during summer months when people are more likely to recreate on the river. Additionally the neighboring condo residents have expressed a desire for more trees to provide some screening between the parking lot and their homes.
