Summary Description and rationale of project and funding sources:

Important Long Range Transportation, Active Transportation connection from Missoula College to University of Montana via pedestrian bridge over Clark Fork River and River Front Triangle to McCormick Park pedestrian bridge.

History & Current Status: Impact if Cancelled or Delayed

The Missoula College to University of Montana pedestrian bridge would connect the north riverfront Ron's River trail (east of MC) to rest of system (in line with LRTP, transportation plans, supported by University). This would be a partnership with the University and the City, and reduce congestion between on Broadway and Madison. The River Front Triangle to McCormick Park pedestrian bridge would provide pedestrian connectivity across the Clark Fork River from downtown to the riverfront park and trail system, which helps address congestion and parking challenges on both sides of the river.
