Summary Description and rationale of project and funding sources:								
<p>As part of the North Riverside Parks and Trails Plan the lawn area adjacent to the Caras Park pavilion is to be replaced with a flat lawn and seat wall. Stormwater will be installing a stormwater infiltration gallery under this lawn space in Fall 2021. Parks and Stormwater is collaborating on design development to incorporate the park improvements into the existing project. City Council approved a contract amendment with the consulting engineers to add the park improvements to the design project. FY22 funds indicate come from Missoula Downtown Association, The Business Improvement District, and Downtown Foundation and Park District.</p>								
History & Current Status: Impact if Cancelled or Delayed								
<p>Project is strongly advocated, and funded by the MDA, BID, and downtown foundation. In order to limit disruption to park visitors, including revenue generating events, and to take advantage of design and construction efficiencies, Parks and Recreation, working with the Public Works department proposes combining the storm water project with certain park improvements in order to reduce overall design and construction costs, as well as limit disruptions to the park and park visitors.</p>								
Cost Efficiencies & Savings:								
<p>Amending the existing contract to include the park improvements will result in an estimated professional services savings of \$ 29,050. Based on quantity of scale, and other factors the estimated savings of constructing the projects at the same time is \$70,500.</p>
