Adoption of Missoula City Public Works Standards and Specifications Manual

PURPOSE:

The purpose of Administrative Rule No. 112 is to formally adopt the *Missoula City Public Works Standards and Specifications Manual* and subsequent manual updates.

APPLICABILITY:

This manual applies to infrastructure improvements within the city and replaces existing City Engineering and Public Works administrative rules, design and construction standards that currently exist in Missoula municipal code, specific design and construction requirements in the City Subdivision Regulations, and specific modifications to the existing Montana Public Works Standard Specifications. It provides guidance for the uniform design and construction of infrastructure within right of way and public easements, including streets, drinking water, sanitary sewer, and storm water facilities. It also applies to other utilities, grading, drainage, erosion control, and landscaping. The manual additionally provides the minimum standards, specifications, and processes necessary to promote public safety, functional effectiveness, and consistency of materials and establishes the methods to be used for plan review and acceptance.

The manual is considered a "living document" and will be updated annually as needed to address industry changes and other areas that may require further consideration or clarification.
