Summary Description and rationale of project and funding sources:

Reconfigure to add bicycle facilities and turn lanes to improve safety and traffic operations per Downtown Master Plan recommendations. Corridor safety study and interim improvements would be funded by MPO Planning Funds and Road District in FY21-22. Long term improvements would be funded by a combination of MRA, BaRSAA, and Grants/Federal Funding in FY24-25.

History & Current Status: Impact if Cancelled or Delayed

This project provides improved safety, connectivity, and circulation for all modes; improves retail environment; supports transit. Hip strip portion is critical missing link in bike network - among top 2 or 3 most requested bike connections in City. Serious injury crash involving a cyclist occurred in 2020. 13 ped crashes including 3 serious injuries, and 34 bicycle injuries including 6 serious injuries have occurred over the past 13 years. This project builds on significant investment in improvements to the Higgins Bridge.

Requires traffic engineering, MDT approvals, outreach to Hip Strip Assoc, Downtown Assoc, neighborhood, adjacent property owners and businesses.
