Summary Description and rationale of project and funding sources:							
<p>Stormwater quality improvements, required by our MS4 Permit, include maintenance of existing storm water infrastructure and addition of new, necessary infrastructure to remove pollutants prior to discharge into our local waterbodies. We have identified multiple improvements that will reduce roadway overtopping, premature asphalt deterioration, erosion, sediment pollution, and improve overall water quality: South Hills ARPA, South Hills Stormwater System Outfall and Bitterroot Swale, City of Missoula Comprehensive Stormwater Plan, Creekwood Crossing Drainage Improvements, Majestic Storm Drain Improvements, and Grant Creek Realignment.</p>							
History & Current Status: Impact if Cancelled or Delayed							
<p>If any of the projects are delayed or cancelled it will directly affect compliance with the City's MS4 Permit. Most of the streams and rivers that receive storm water discharge are considered impaired by the Montana Department of Environmental Quality. There are approved Total Maximum Daily Loads and Wasteload Allocations assigned to these waterbodies and the MS4. The City is required to address the causes of impairment and reduce pollutant loading to these impaired systems.</p>

<p>Potential for coordinating private property access, obtaining stream permitting and environmental regulatory compliance, and working with the University of Montana.</p>
