**Summary Description and rationale of project and funding sources:**

Downtown Lions Park is part of the adopted North Riverside Parks and Trails Master Plan. Since plan adoption Native Americans Against Drugs and Alcohol (NAADA), All Nations Health Center, Game Time, and Parks and Recreation have begun a partnership to implement the Downtown Lions Master Plan. Improvements include a childrens play space with emphasis on health and exercise, a community garden, a picnic/gathering space, art and lighting.

**History & Current Status: Impact if Cancelled or Delayed**

Master Plan was developed in 2020 and with the city's acquisition of Flynn Lowney Ditch, which reaches it terminus into the Clark Fork river proximate to the southern Park boundary there may be opportunity to gain efficiencies ias the projects related to the Flynn Lowney Ditch take shape.
