1. How will request assist in achieving Department Goal and benefit the customer

This request provides resources to extend the useful life and safe operation of park and trail infrastructure for the residents of Missoula and prioritize high priority projects in order to support community design and livability. Taking care of assets in the Parks system provide for a high level of inclusion and opportunity in that they are open and available to the public near to where they live and work. Depending on ongoing funding, this list will be prioritized to address most urgent needs. Prioritized FY24 PAM projects to include: • Drainage infrastructure (risk/liability management) • Variable Frequency Drive (Efficiency, increase in water right and utility savings) • Playground Repairs-as needed (risk/liability management) • Crack seal/seal coat trail segments and sport courts (Extend useful life of asphalt) • Pathway-replacement (risk/liability management) • Parking lot repairs and patching (Extend useful life of asphalt) • Misc. sidewalk, well, irrigation, bridge and fence repairs (Extend usefrequests are for: • replacement Sacajewea restroom that was funded via Park District # 1 fund balance in FY23 and not accomplished due to capacity of staff. • reconstruct the next priority in the system for sport court upgrades, (Skyview Park). • continue cyclical engineering assessments of priority bridges in the system.

2. What specifically is needed to achieve this goal?

The adopted Park Asset Management Plan identified annual cyclical funding needs of ~\$258K in 2014 dollars. This request continues the incremental progress toward reaching this goal and would increase annual appropriations for city park cyclical maintenance from \$167K to \$267K.
