**Summary Description and rationale of project and funding sources:**

The Kiwanis Park master plan was envisioned in the North Riverside Parks and Trails Master Plan. Part of this plan calls for better trail connectivity from Front Street through the park to Ron's River Trail. This trail would provide an important connection to the new Missoula Library, and is a heavily used corridor for students to commute to the University. Currently this trail is gravel, too steep to meet ADA and is discontinuous through the park. The proposed improvements would connect Front Street with the park with an ADA accessible paved trail that meets CPTED and AASHTO standards. The Kiwanis Club of Missoula is partnering with Missoula Parks and Recreation to design and construct the portion of the trail from Front street down to the picnic shelter and playground. If funding allows, the trail will be extended to connect all the way to Ron's River trail.

**History & Current Status: Impact if Cancelled or Delayed**

The new Missoula Library is directly across Front Street from Kiwanis park, making this a very important pedestrian and active transportation gateway from the park and trail system along the river into downtown. If the project is delayed or cancelled the current safety concerns around CPTED and accessibility of this section of park will remain and the city will miss an opportunity to connect the commuter trail system with the Missoula Library and downtown.
