<b>Summary Description and rationale of project and funding sources:</b>							
The Missoula City Cemetery strategic plan indicates the need for a new office building. In order to start the process of building a new facility, an architect was hired and completed a schematic design and floor plan. The new plan will allow for more functional and sustainable use of the building for many years to come. It will fulfill programmatic requirements and long term sustainability and energy efficiency goals. The landscape design that accompanies the building's architecture will improve the overall aesthetics of the space and increase appeal for a growing population. Funding will be sourced from the sale of auxiliary land currently owned by the Cemetery and remainder will go to Affordable Housing Trust Fund. Expenses in FY25 will come from the Cemetery Capital Reserve Fund 1242.							
<b>History &amp; Current Status: Impact if Cancelled or Delayed</b>							
The current office building was built in 1940 and is aging and in need of serious repair. The strategic plan states that the building will need to be replaced over time. Delaying this process could result in larger repair bills, and more serious work needing to be done in the future. The strategic plan and architect recommendations are for deconstruction and replacement of the current office building. Their estimated cost of sitework, deconstruction and replacement is \$1,442,119.00
