Summary Description and rationale of project and funding sources:

There are 5 recently approved developments that have been required to install City owned lighting system on collector streets. These 5 developments will be reimbursed for capital costs for designing, manufacturing, and installing these collector street lights. City staff are working to create Special Improvement Lighting Districts for phases of these developments where lighting will be installed along adjacent collector streets. These SILDs will reimburse the City over a period of 15-years for its payment to developers of the capital costs of the lighting systems necessary to illuminate collector streets.

History & Current Status: Impact if Cancelled or Delayed

The 5 developments are in various stages of the design and installation process with some of the street lighting already installed. Delay would cost the developers money they invested into the City owned lighting system.

Are there any site requirements/ Potentially Affected Interest (PAI) Coordination:

Existing homeowners are potentially affected interest. These homeowners will have an opportunity for comment through the process of City Council hearing of potential creation of these lighting districts.
