Summary Description and rationale of project and funding sources:							
<p>In 2018, Knife River corporation donated a 90 ac. parcel along the Bitterroot River to the City of Missoula. This parcel is adjacent to Ft. Missoula Regional park but access to the parcel is largely across University of Montana Property. Currently, the parcel is closed to the public but City staff and partnering agencies and non-profits have been collecting natural and cultural resource data from site. We have discovered that the site has regionally significant cultural and wildlife values. It also has great potential to supply unique recreational &amp; educational opportunities to underserved segments of our population. A community developed Master Plan for the parcel is needed. Partial funding for this planning process may be generated through partnership agreements.</p>							
History & Current Status: Impact if Cancelled or Delayed							
<p>This site is currently closed to the public but trespass onto the property increases every year. User made trails, beach access and vandalism has greatly increased on the property. The longer the City takes to develop and manage recreational access on site the more resource damage and irresponsible recreational trends will develop. Multiple funding opportunities for site development/improvement/restoration exist. Completion of a Master Plan would allow the City to pursue grants and private donations to implement the master plan.</p>
