Summary Description and rationale of project and funding sources:

Provides for engineering, design and construction of planned major facilities including Recreation Center expansion, removal and relocation of operations facility at 100 Hickory, addition of sport courts, addition of 100 person picnic shelter; replacement of ballfield lighting, and reconstruction of parking lots. Prior funding comes from impact fees and were used to develop a conceptual master plan for a planned phase II addition to Currents Aquatics Center, Currents Center for Recreation and Creativity. The conceptual master plan was adopted by City Council on May 23rd, 2022. Parks and Recreation continues to work with community partners to forward the project.

History & Current Status: Impact if Cancelled or Delayed

Requested funding provides for planned improvements, upgrades and replacements. Costs for construction continue to increase. FY22 and prior funds resulted in an approved conceptual master plan for Currents Center for Recreation and Creativity

Are there any site requirements/ Potentially Affected Interest (PAI) Coordination:

Indoor recreation space is one of the greatest needs in the City, especially important to address equal access and equity for seniors, low-income families, and individuals with seasonal sensitivities such as allergies, wildfire smoke, and extremes of hot and cold. Further, the space provides safe public access for diverse population.
