- Improved cost allocation processes to better understand cost of services

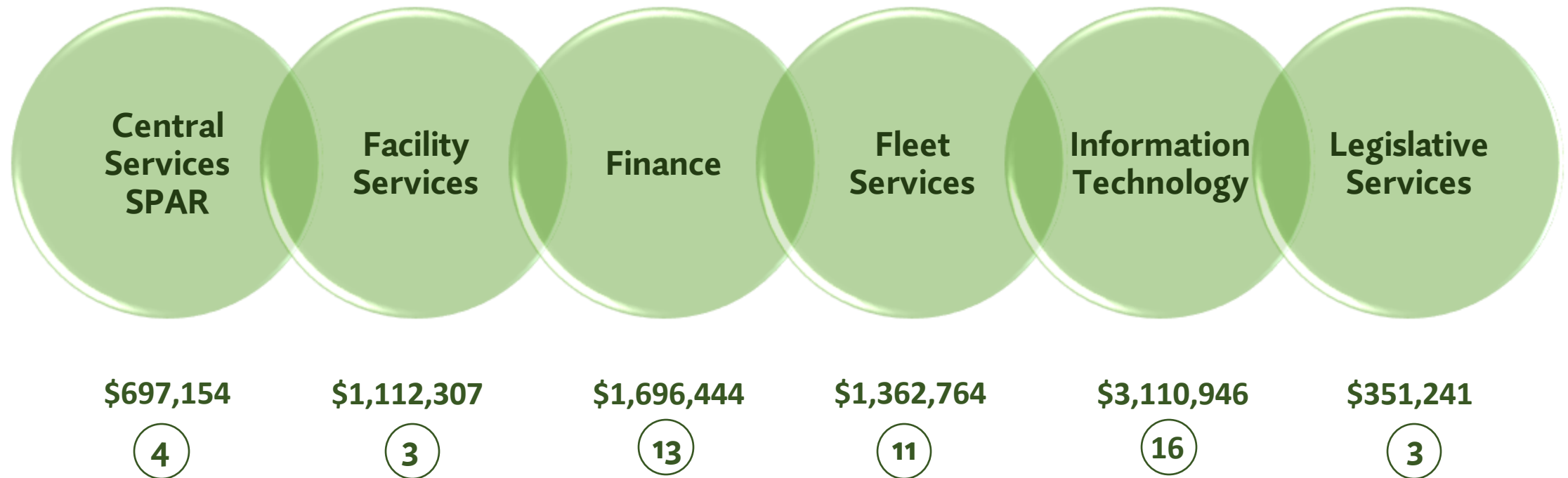

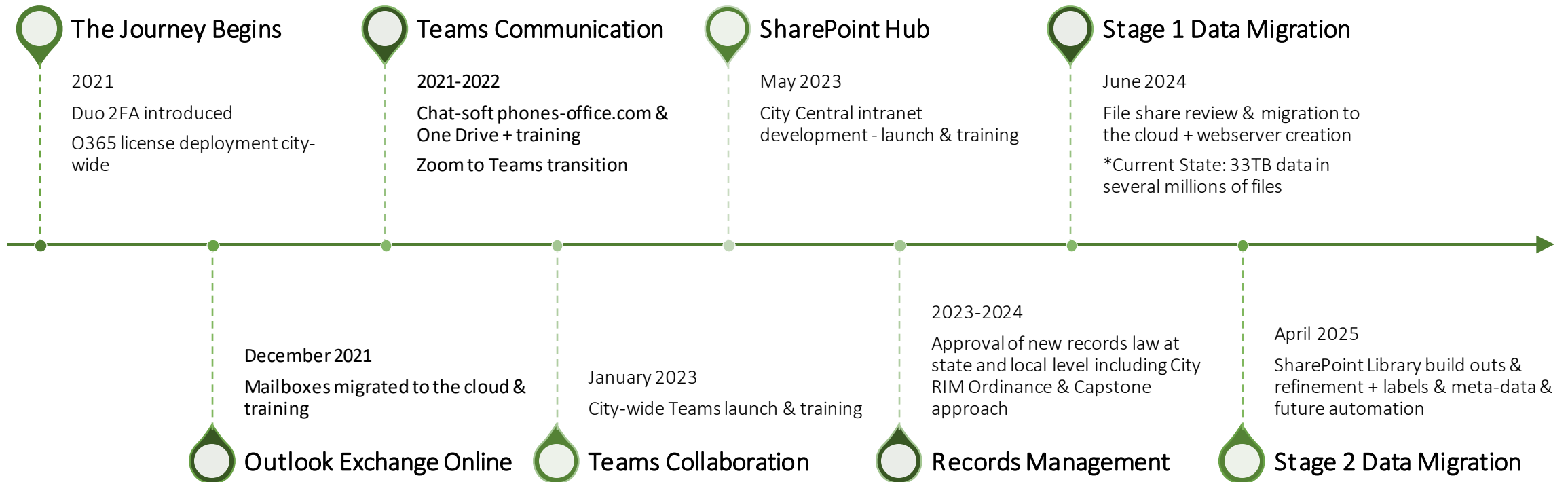

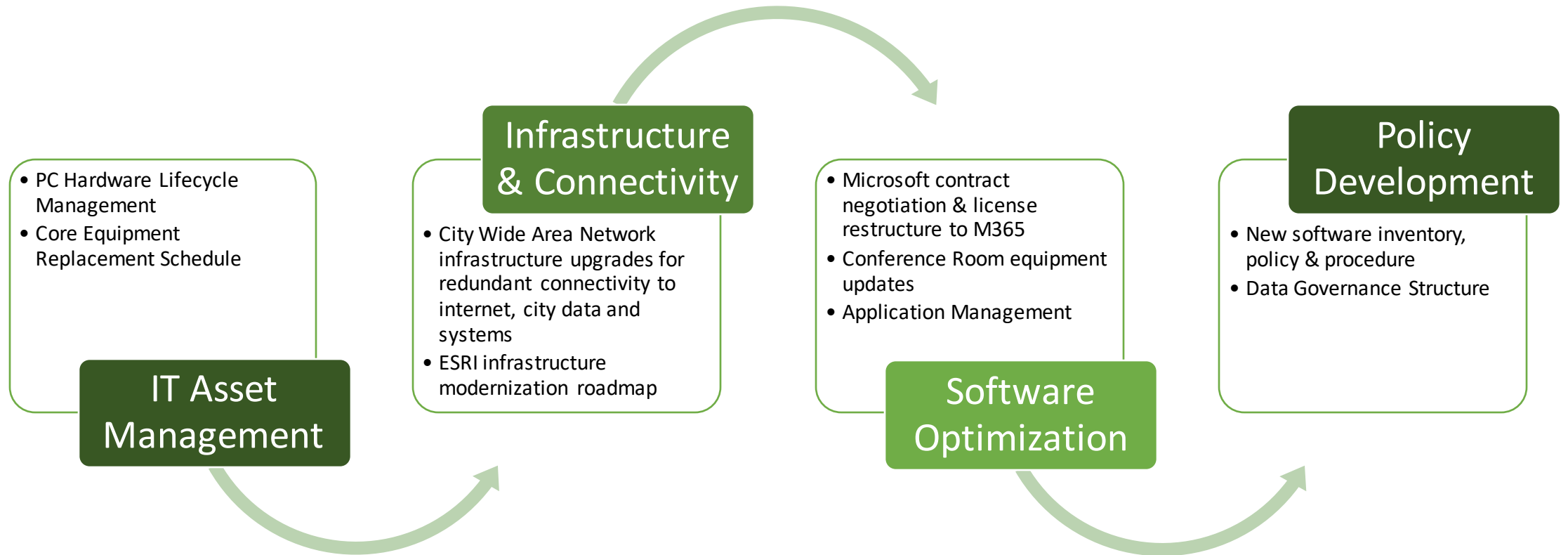

- Successfully managing operating costs

Rehabilitation

- Complete building investigation (seismic, water intrusion, hazardous materials, etc.)
- Complete master planning and schematic design
- Commence deconstruction and abatement

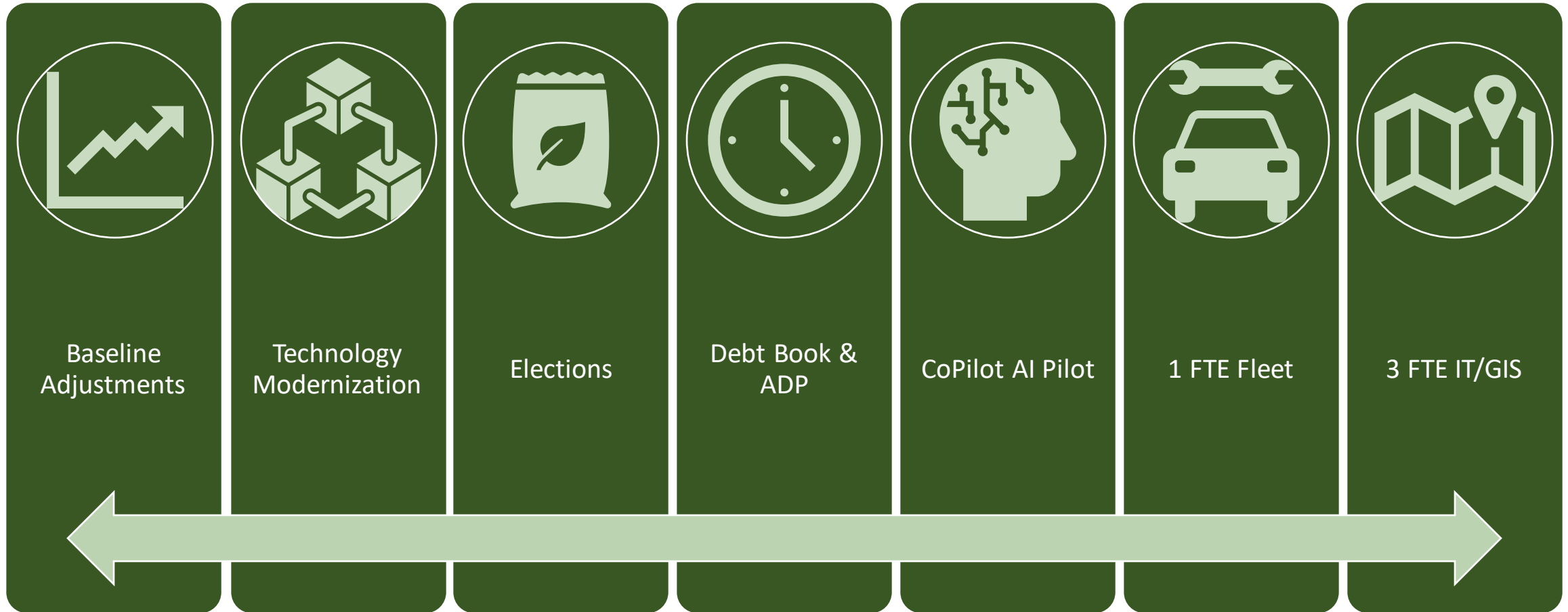

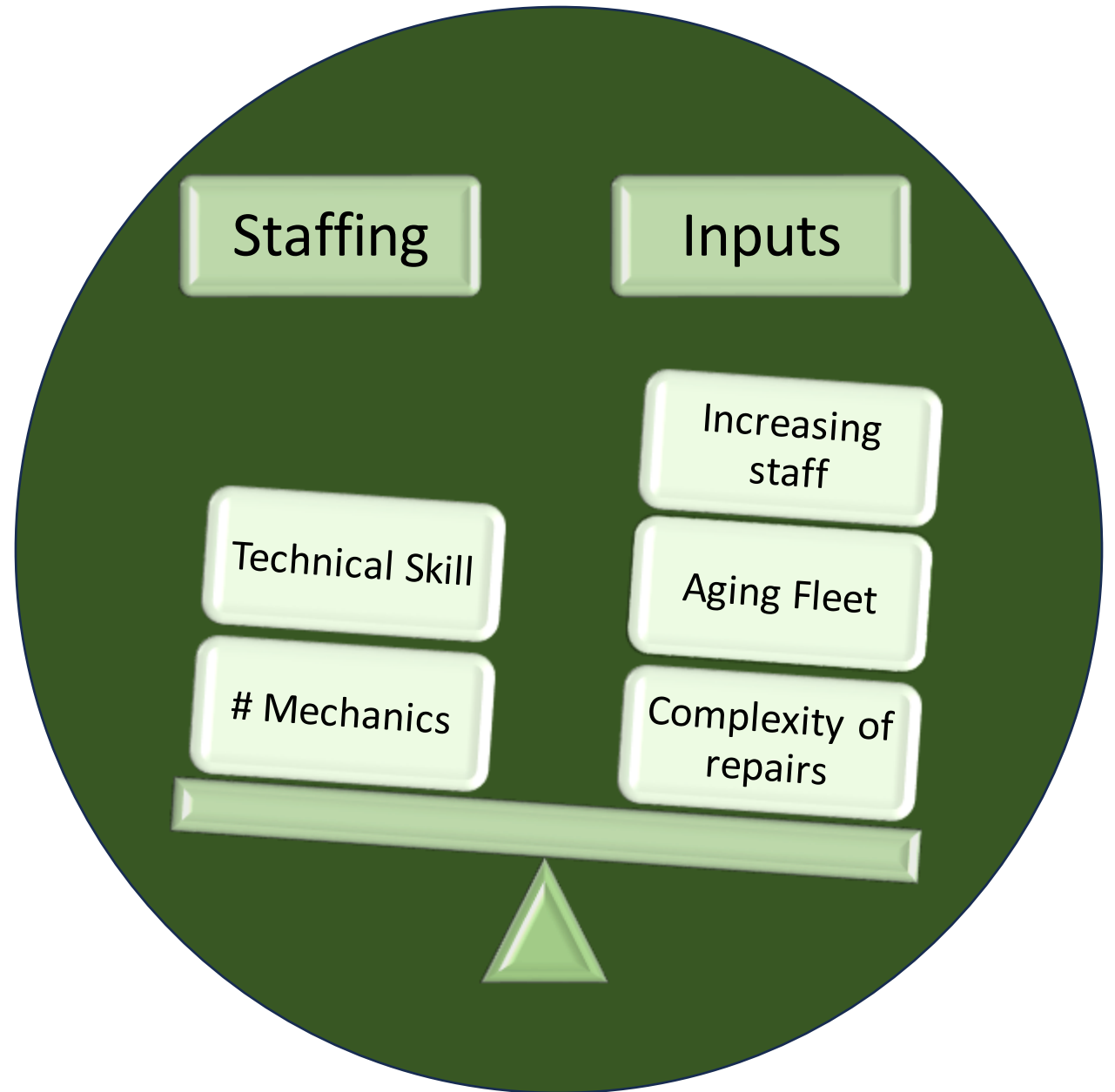

Information Technology

Public Safety IT Support Specialist \$85,300

Partner with and complement existing specialist to support increased technology needs in both the city Fire and Police Departments

Support critical niche services and tools used by public safety employees.

GIS Technician \$91,373

Maintain level of service for mapping tools and 3 key services

- Centralized GIS platform supporting data management and access city-wide
- Authoritative spatial data creation and management
- Map-based data products used for data visualization and data management

This entry level position enables other staff to develop advanced information products and to support asset management and data driven decision making.

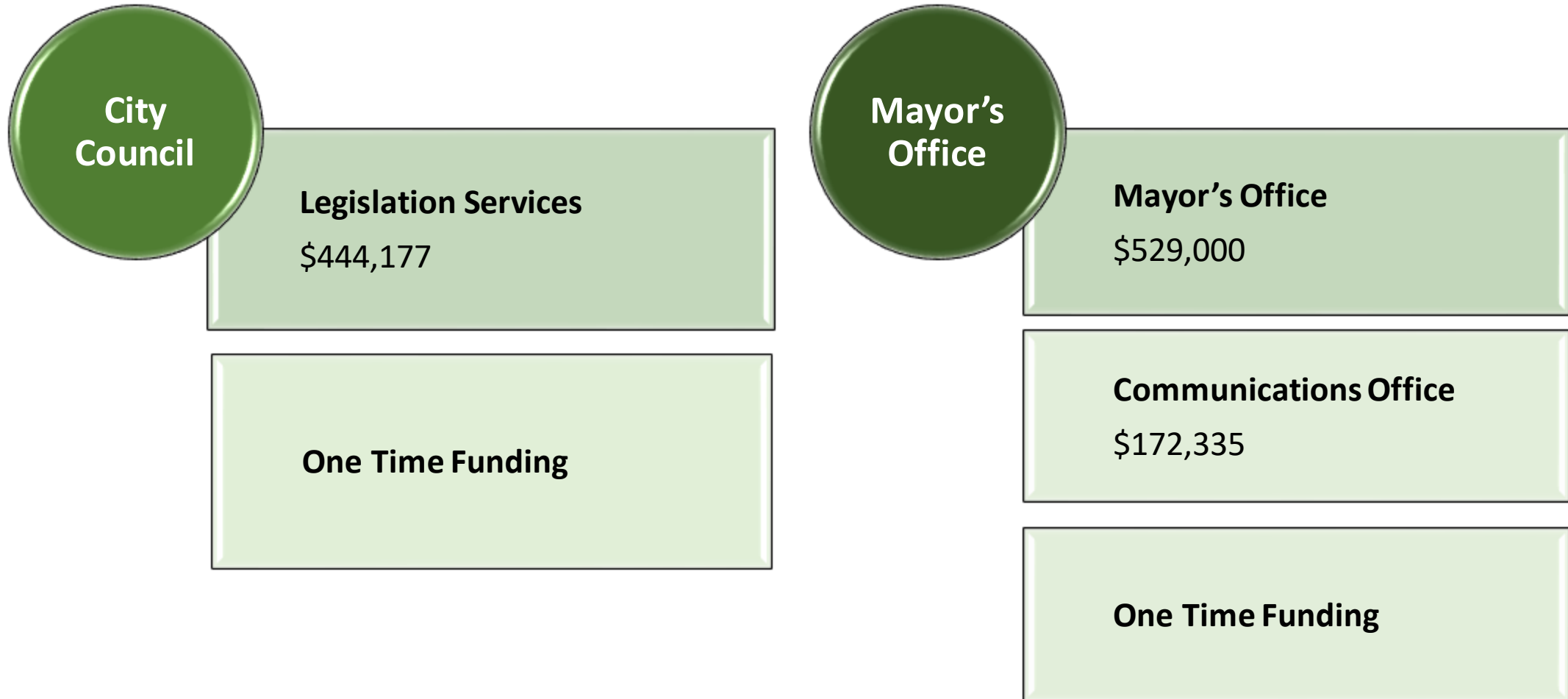
