



2025 STREET MAINTENANCE CHIP AND SEAL PROGRAM

From July 21st-August 7th, (weather permitting) the City of Missoula will be applying CHIP SEAL to streets Mon – Thurs, 7:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

CHIP SEALING is the process of applying a layer of asphalt oil sealant then covering it with a layer of small “chip” rock.

CHIP SEALING keeps out moisture and protects the street surface, which helps prevent potholes and increases asphalt life expectancy.

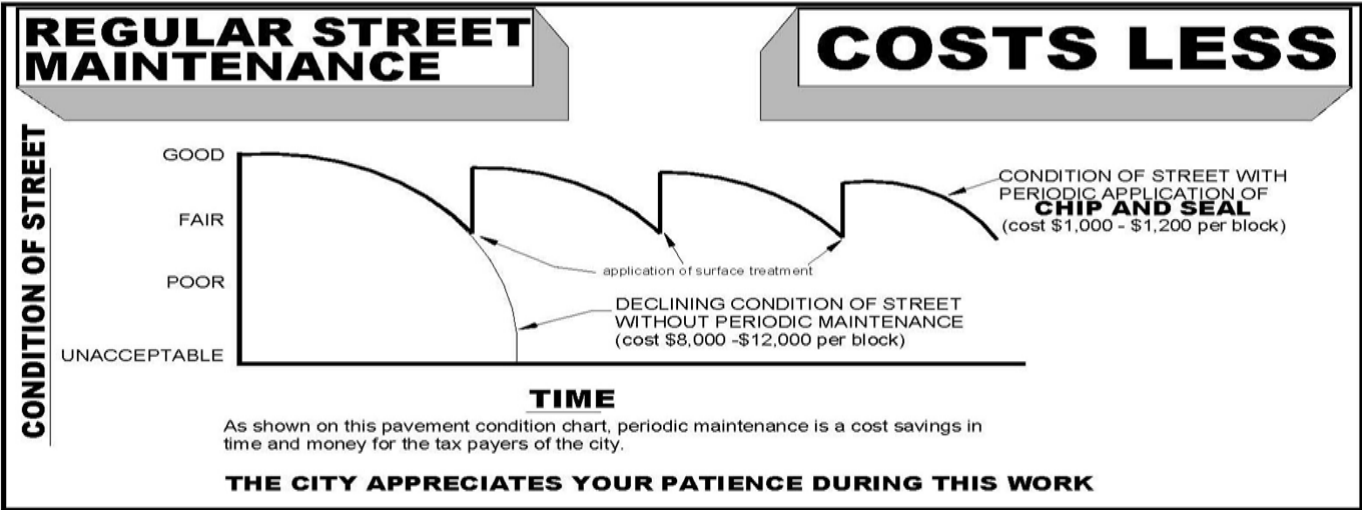
CHIP SEALING is only one quarter of the cost of a new asphalt surface, which allows the City to maintain more streets.

If chip sealing is planned for your neighborhood, please be aware of the following:

- **DO NOT** run sprinklers the day before or day of chip sealing; the street must be dry.
- **PARK AWAY** from the streets being chip sealed. *Cars remaining on the street will be towed, usually within one block of original location.*
- **ENSURE** your trees are pruned to a minimum of 14 feet over the street to the inside edge of the curb line, per MMC 12.32. If they are not, the City may need to trim them.
- **BE AWARE** there may be traffic delays during chip seal application.
- **DRIVE SLOWLY** over the newly chip sealed area for the first two days.
- **REFRAIN** from making excessively sharp turns.
- **BE AWARE** loose rock chips will be left on the street for two to three weeks until street sweeping is completed. For the next year, the street will have a rough surface due to the “chips” and will also have some loose “chip” rock, which will eventually be cleaned up.

ALERT:

- If you walk on the oil before the chips have been applied, you may wish to remove your shoes before entering a house or car. This oil is nearly impossible to remove from rugs or carpet. Business and homeowners may want to cover rugs in entryways for a couple of weeks to avoid oil being tracked in.
- Weather and/or workload could change the scheduling. Street Maintenance crew will post “No Parking” barricades with flyers the day before any street is chip sealed



The streets benefiting from chip seal are listed below in a tentative order in which they will be completed. Weather and/or workload could alter the scheduling.
