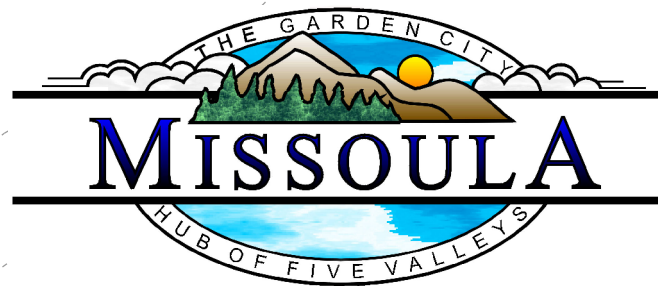

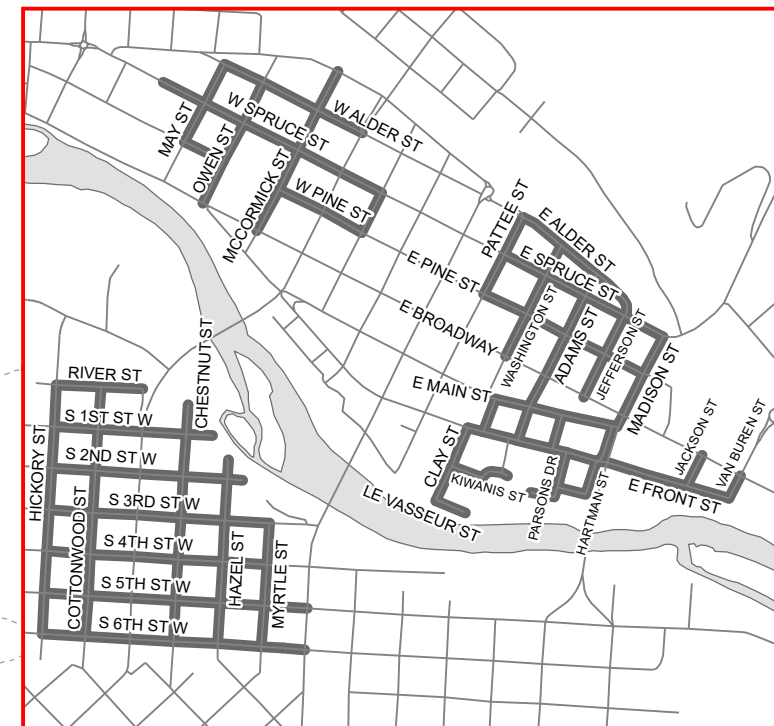

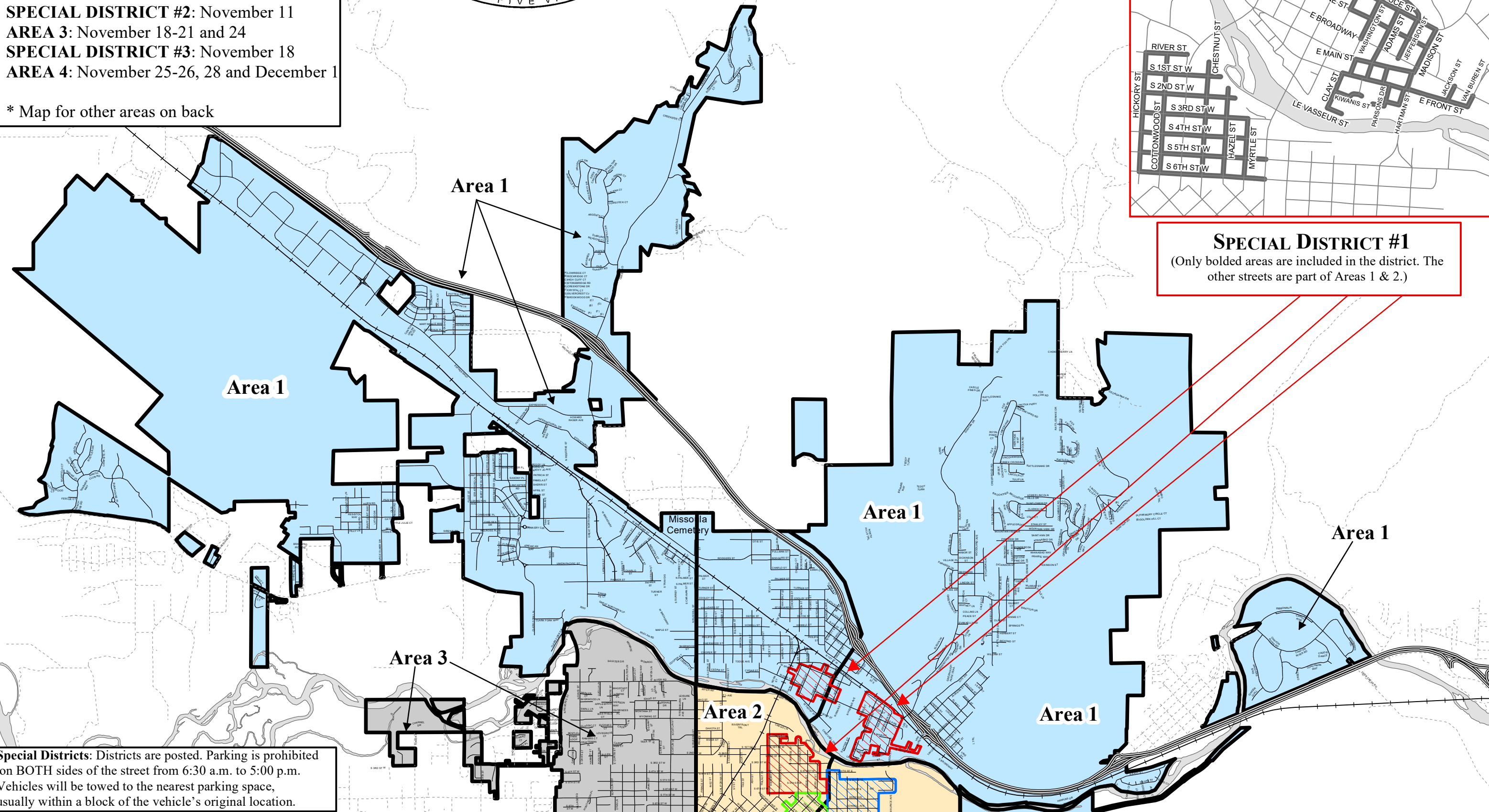


2025 LEAF COLLECTION SCHEDULE

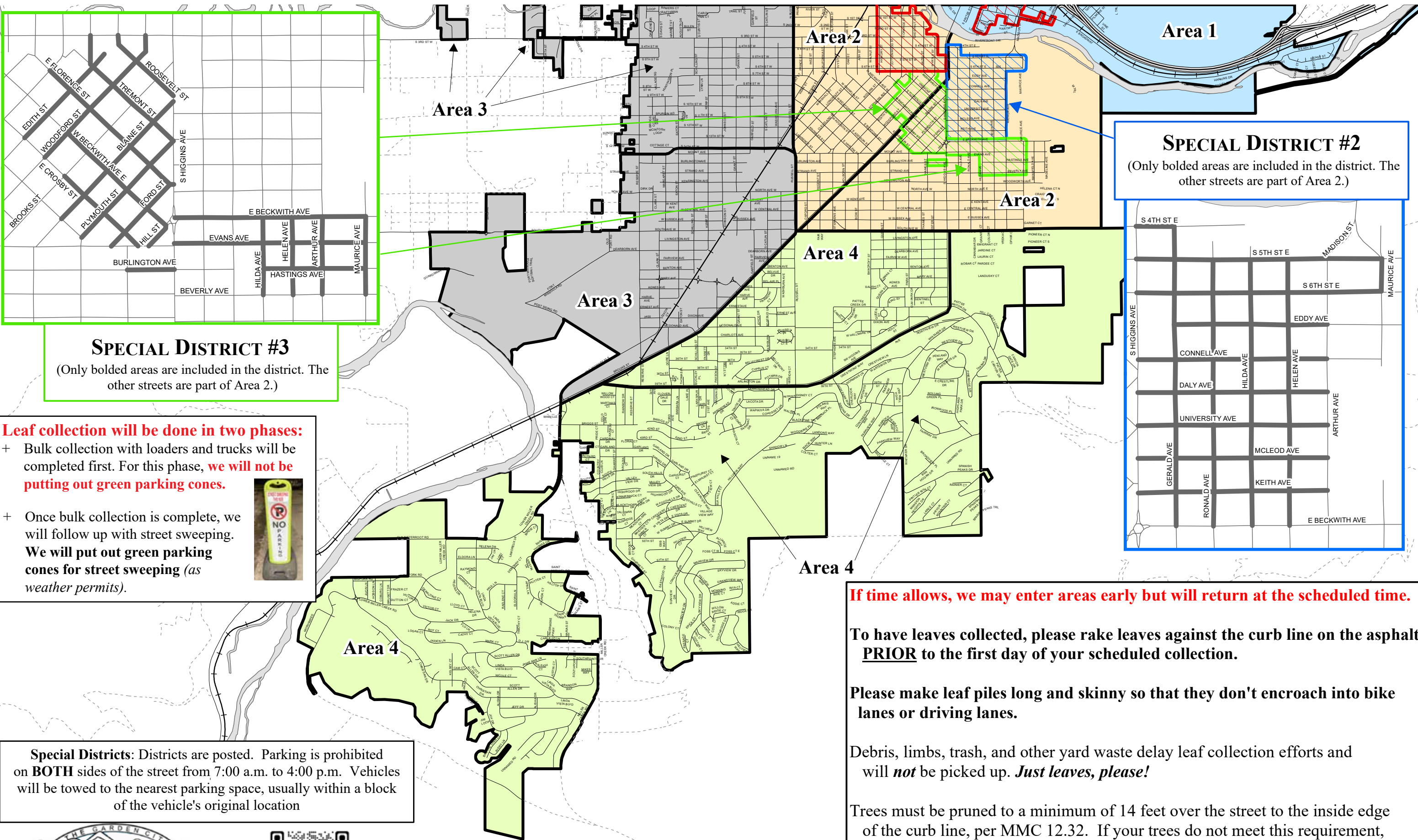


SPECIAL DISTRICT #1

(Only bolded areas are included in the district. The other streets are part of Areas 1 & 2.)



Special Districts: Districts are posted. Parking is prohibited on BOTH sides of the street from 6:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Vehicles will be towed to the nearest parking space, usually within a block of the vehicle's original location.



SPECIAL DISTRICT #2
(Only bolded areas are included in the district. The other streets are part of Area 2.)

SPECIAL DISTRICT #3
(Only bolded areas are included in the district. The other streets are part of Area 2.)

Leaf collection will be done in two phases:

- + Bulk collection with loaders and trucks will be completed first. For this phase, **we will not be putting out green parking cones.**
- + Once bulk collection is complete, we will follow up with street sweeping. **We will put out green parking cones for street sweeping (as weather permits).**



Special Districts: Districts are posted. Parking is prohibited on **BOTH** sides of the street from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Vehicles will be towed to the nearest parking space, usually within a block of the vehicle's original location

If time allows, we may enter areas early but will return at the scheduled time.

To have leaves collected, please rake leaves against the curb line on the asphalt **PRIOR** to the first day of your scheduled collection.

Please make leaf piles long and skinny so that they don't encroach into bike lanes or driving lanes.

Debris, limbs, trash, and other yard waste delay leaf collection efforts and will **not** be picked up. ***Just leaves, please!***

Trees must be pruned to a minimum of 14 feet over the street to the inside edge of the curb line, per MMC 12.32. If your trees do not meet this requirement, the city may trim them in order to complete the leaf collection.
